The college has an extremely vigilant committee on anti-ragging to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging of any type within the college campus. The Committee includes faculty members and student volunteers from different departments. The committee meets often and when needed to discuss the anti- ragging directives received from NCISM and put them into action. The committee also actively discuss its functioning and activities to be undertaken throughout the academic session. The anti-ragging committee is reconstituted every year like any other staff association committee as per the college directive. It ensures the implementation of the preventive measure and undertakes frequent and surprise checks/ visits to ensure ragging free campus.

Broadly put ragging is any act resulting in mental/physical and sexual abuse, verbal abuse, and indecent behaviour, criminal intimidation/wrong restraint, under mining human dignity, financial exploitation and use of force. As per the guidelines of NCISM and Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath Ayush University, Gorakhpur ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, excitement by rough or rude treatment.
- Handling, including rowdy, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance.
- Undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehensive fear in a fresher.
- Asking the students to do any act or perform something which any student would not do in the ordinary course and which causes him/her shame or embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc.



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Punishment for Participation in/or Abetment of Ragging:

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4.5 Years or equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
10. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-

Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee:

The Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a culture of **Ragging Free Environment** in the college Campus. The student volunteers will work under the supervision of Anti Ragging committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. The Anti-Ragging committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plans for curbing the menace of ragging in the college by adopting an array of activities.

Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Committee:

- To keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of student aggregation including, classrooms, canteen, grounds, lawns etc.
- Mandated Orientation Programme for fresher's and parents to familiarize them with the institutional rules and regulations inclusive of anti-ragging measures, what constitutes ragging and the consequences to be faced.
- Prepare fresher's not to oblige to such practices if at all they face any but to report boldly.
- As a preventive measure a member of the committee is appointed during the admission procedure throughout.
- Regular policing by the committee members, and student's volunteers members in the beginning of the odd semester every year.
- To educate the students by adopting various means about the menace of ragging and related punishments there too.
- Assurance to maintain their confidentiality if reported.
- Make discrete random surveys.



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Initiatives to prevent the menace of ragging:

- Put up posters on Anti ragging on notice boards and at various vantage points in the college campus.
- Anti-Ragging complaint box will be installed at various places in the college so that students can freely and fearlessly contact the committee.
- Various competitions like essay writing, slogan writing, extempore and poster making on themes/topics related to ragging and anti-ragging will be organised to create awareness among students and sensitize the young minds on various aspects of ragging.
- Anti-ragging campaign/rallies will be organised within and outside the college campus to generate awareness. Enthusiastic students usually participate in these campaign rallies with charts, posters and boards with anti-ragging slogans written on them.
- Keeping in mind the present scenario to maintain and follow social distancing norms webinars will be organised (instead of seminar) to educate the students about various aspects of ragging and how it can be completely eradicated.

Future Plans:

- Arrange for professional counseling sessions to prevent any untoward incidents to both seniors and fresher's.
- Appoint mentoring cells involving senior students of college.
